DON'T PACK!

- Sweatshirt and/or coat
- Raincoat/Poncho and rain boots
- Sneakers, water shoes
- Sleeping bag and pillow; sleeping mat or foam pad is optional
- 2-3 pairs of long pants; 4 t-shirts
- 2-3 pairs of shorts; P.J.'s
- SOCKS AND UNDERWARE
- Bathing Suit, Beach Towel
- A Normal Hat & A Silly Hat
- Towel, Facecloth, soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, hairbrush, shampoo, etc.
- Flashlight, Reading Book/Journal
- Sunscreen/Bugspray
- Water bottle
- Outfit for Party - Theme – **Games Of Life**
- **CELL PHONES, iPods, Radios, tvs, palm pilots, DS's, and all other electronics are to be left at home**
- Money – There will be no opportunity for your child to spend money at camp.
- Food / Snacks – There will be plenty to eat at camp. Food in the cabins will invite unwanted animals, bugs and pests.
- Valuables – Any expensive clothing, jewelry, etc. are better left home
- Knives – Pocket knives and hunting knives are NOT allowed at camp
- Lighters are NOT allowed at camp
- Squirt guns and other toys, are not needed at camp

Campers are responsible for bringing their own factor and supplies with them to camp; and be sure to take extra. Parents are to be reminded that all factor/drugs should be packed properly, clearly marked with your child's name. Also, Sneakers are a MUST, campers that arrive without sneakers, WILL be sent out to buy a pair.

Directions to Camp:

Take Exit 8 off of Highway 102. If traveling from Truro direction, hang a left. If traveling from Halifax direction hang a right. Drive through the set of lights at the mall. After approx. 1 km you will reach another set of lights. Drive straight through those set of lights. At this point the road turns into Hwy 224. Follow this road for 20 – 30 minutes, roughly 26 kms, and you will see the sign and campground on your right.

Do not go towards Coldstream and if you reach Middle Musquodobit you have gone too far.
