Enclosed you will find a list of what to pack and what not to pack for camp. Please use this list and follow the requests that we have asked, especially with the contraband items. Please take notice of the note stating that your kids **WILL NOT** be permitted to stay at camp **WITHOUT** a pair of sneakers! Direction to camp will be found at the bottom of this form.

If transportation is an issue, **PLEASE** contact one of us immediately. Transportation **CAN BE** provided if given plenty of notice. Registration is from 3 - 4pm on Sunday, August 18th and pick up is at 12pm (noon) on Saturday, August 24th. Please try to not come any earlier than the time stated as we will not be ready for you and it can cause disruption to the program.

Again, as in previous years, if space permits, each camper gets the opportunity to bring along a friend to camp. We determine this by first allowing the new campers and youngest campers to bring a friend along and then if there is still room the oldest can be accompanied as well. We would also like to remind parents of the campers that it is your responsibility to keep the parents of your child's "buddy" informed on what is going on.

The registration fees this year will be \$125 per camper. This is only 1/5th of the actual cost for a child for the week of camp, but as in previous years, your chapter covers the remaining costs.
